cabin chic

Shared by two teenaged boys, this bathroom was designed for double duty, with a natural, woodsy aesthetic that'll stand the test of time.

A narrow freestanding bathtub is tucked into the corner of the room in case someone needs a soak. In a clever space-saving move, a niche built into the wall provides a smart spot for storing toiletries.

A simple porcelain tile floor that resembles natural stone echoes the grey countertop—a combination that enhances the rustic vibe of the room.

Wood-look tiles on one wall and a barely-there taupe paint on the others imbue this bathroom with a neutral backdrop and instant warmth.



A touch of frost on the clear glass shower enclosure provides just the right amount of privacy while keeping the bathroom streamlined.

Woven bath mats that boast a playful pattern add coziness, texture and some whimsy to the scheme.



Bathroom essentials need not be on display! This vanity features lots of drawers to allow for optimal organization.

industrial black and white

This unique family bathroom is a bright, luxe space thanks to its stunning pattern play.

A white, oval freestanding bathtub rounds out the hard lines in the room and provides a beautiful contrast to the hexagonal black tiling. Bonus: The faucet retracts so it doesn't poke bathers in the back.

Large black geometric tiles and white rectangular ones laid in a herringbone pattern create two distinct spaces in one room. The vertical band of small hex tiles transitions and unifies the look. The same small hex tile treatment is used as an accent in the shower niches and vanity backsplash to pull it all together.

← The sleek black vanity (boasting lots of storage space) fits right in with the subtle herringbone pattern of the floor tiles and the white walls. Its off-set sink gives ample counter space alongside.

Slim, modern and totally high-tech, the shower fixture, which includes a rain cap and removable shower head, is as pretty as it is practical, and makes the morning ritual a dream.

Three large shower niches make room for products galore for every member of the family—the bottom one is easily accessible for small kiddos while the top shelf is high enough to keep dangerous accessories out of their reach.

A glass-enclosed shower keeps the design open and fresh, and shows off the stunning tile-work and state-of-the-art fixture inside.

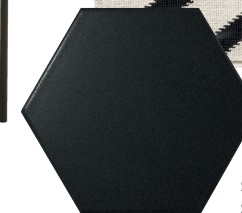

A large frameless mirror placed above subtle elongated hexagonal tiles on the backsplash provides a clean, fresh finish.

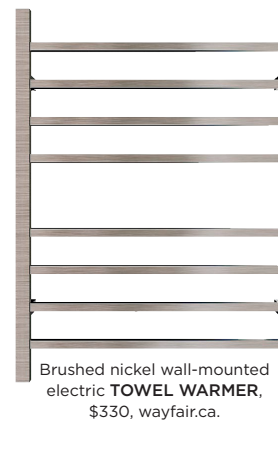
Though there's room for two sinks on this vanity, installing only one ensures ample counter space. The durable quartz countertop is built to last.
